are fighting against musical boundaries, making our website (www.d-i-r-t-y.com), setting up parties (monthly at the famous Parisian club, 'Le Paris Paris'), and releasing compilations (« Dirty diamonds », three volumes on Diamondtraxx Records) made by nerds for non-nerds. Since our last opus in 2006, we launched a series of 12 inches (the « Dirty Edits », acclaimed by Laurent Garnier, Ivan Smagghe, Optimo, DJ Naughty, Erol Alkan, Ewan Pearson...), we've been playing our dj-not-dj sets all over the world (Miami, Berlin, Istanbul, Londres, Montreal, Copenhagen...), and we also created a blog which is being a great success despite an unlikely name : www.alainfinkielkrautrock.com. Today we've found the appropriate label for our artistic ambitions : Tigersushi, which is owned by our favorite French producer Joakim.

After three « all-over-the-place » compilations, we're coming back with a new thematic compilation series, injecting a certain dose of subjectivity, bad faith, and never yielding to self-content feelings - the main danger of that exercise. Our mission is simple : to blow away musical boundaries, to make underground music accessible to everyone, to decode musical trends by finding these little known but essential songs, and to carefully avoid dogmatism.

This first volume is devoted to what we call « Space Disco » that you may also call Cosmic Disco. Don't listen to the gatekeepers, they're only watching after their own neurosis and they'll tell you « This isn't real cosmic disco ! ». Maybe they are right but, who cares ? Many things in this record feed an alternative vision of the genre : from cosmic disco (popularized in Italy in the early eighties by Daniele Baldelli), to new wave, to slow, slow, slow disco (« Slow is the new fast » says Alain Finkielkrautrock). Dirty Space Disco is our summer compilation, a real hot record but also very cold. Two last points : artwork has been made by our favorite graphic designers Laurent Fetis & Elisabeth Arkhipoff and the next volume will be dedicated to weird psychedelic French pop from the 70s...
